



Art in Granton: 25-26-27 October 2019

Information for Artists and Makers

The **2019 Art in Granton** exhibition is an open call to ALL Artists and Makers: painters, printmakers, photographers, textile artists, ceramicists, jewellers, composers, poets, new media artists to exhibit and showcase works that respond and relate to or are inspired by the Granton area.

We particularly welcome artworks that take inspiration from the Granton Curious Edinburgh heritage walking tour, which can be downloaded free, check

Key dates

- Monday 30 September 2019: Submission deadline 6pm
- Tuesday 8 October: selection of artists and works confirmed by e-mail
- Monday 14 October: Exhibition Programme announced via the website
- Handing-in times for works selected: Friday 18 October (6-7pm); Saturday 19 October (10-12 noon), Sunday 20 October (2-4pm)
- Exhibition opening times: Friday 25 October (5-8pm); Saturday 26 October (11- 6pm); and Sunday 27 October (11-5pm)
- Picking-up times: Sunday 27 October (5-6pm); Monday 28 October (10-1pm); and Tuesday 29 October (6-8pm)

Submissions

- All entries must be submitted by e-mail to artingranton@grantonhub.org
- A maximum of THREE works may be submitted
- There are no restrictions on media used, nor the size of works submitted, but please consider that gallery space is limited and we may not have the wall space for larger works.
- For each work: please supply the title; the framed dimensions of the work (in cm); and the medium used (eg oil on canvas, mixed media on board, ceramic, glass, wool etc...)
- If submitting music or digital video then please also give the running time (in minutes) and a short description of the piece.
- There is no charge for submitting work, nor for its exhibition, however a fee of 20% on the sale of a work or craft item will be levied on each work SOLD to help cover event costs.

- Works should be supplied suitable for display, mounted and framed where applicable

Images

- Up to three images of EACH work may be sent for e-mail submission, of which one must show the work in its entirety
- Images should be saved as JPEGs with a maximum file size of 1MB, at least 72 dpi, and at least 1000px along the longest edge
- Save EACH image file with your name and the title of your artwork as the filename, eg, john_smith-harbour_view_01.jpg
- Images submitted by the artists and makers may be used by granton:hub for promotional purposes, with credits included where feasible.

Granton

- Artists do not need to be based in the Granton area to submit work, but the essential criteria for selection is that the work MUST be inspired or connected to Granton/Forth Shore.

Selection

- Final selection results will be e-mailed Monday 14 October 2019. Please ensure you check your e-mails regularly and reply with CONFIRMATION that you will hand in your work(s) on one of the days stated above
- In the event of over-subscription, Granton:hub will aim to hang at least one work from each artist. Artists may state their first choice when submitting

Delivering Your Work

- Handing-in times are detailed above. Works can NOT be received outwith these times
- All packaging materials must be removed from Madelvic House
- Short term parking is available outside Madelvic House
- Please attach a LABEL to your work with name, title, price and a contact phone number. Also indicate 'this way up' if appropriate
- Please note postal entries cannot be accepted

Insurance

- Whilst every possible care will be taken of works submitted, Granton:hub cannot be responsible for any loss or damage incurred during the exhibition. Granton:hub does not insure the exhibits. Artists are advised to insure their own work

Sales & Commission

Works may be offered for sale. Artists and makers who have a successful sale will be charged 20% for EACH work sold. Fees are payable by cash or cheque within seven days of the close of the exhibition. Artists and/or their agents are most welcome to attend throughout the exhibition to discuss and promote their work

Plinths and Display Equipment

- The organisers will aim to have plinths available. If artists wish to use their own plinth then please indicate this when submitting your work. Plinths and artworks must be submitted at the same time
- Any specialist display and hanging mechanisms must be clearly outlined in the submission proposal
- If submitting video or music, artists must bring their own equipment. You must ensure equipment is PAT tested and that they have proof of its compliance PRIOR to handing-in

Removal of Works

- Madelvic House is not permanently staffed by Granton:hub organisers and artists are advised to consider the return date and times to collect their work. Sold works must remain in place until the end of the exhibition

Photography

- It will be assumed that the organisers will be able to take photos during the event which can be used on Granton:hub social media and websites. Credits will be included where feasible
